Insurance	National Health Insurance:		
	<ul> <li>National Health Insurance:</li> <li>The Ministry of Health, Labour, and Welfare now requires all College Student Visa holders to become a registered member of the Japan National Health Insurance. All exchange students must enroll. Students will pay monthly premiums (Approximately 2,400 JPY per month). Upon joining this system, students will be charged only 30% of the incurred medical cost.</li> <li>Kobe University PAS :</li> <li>PAS (Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursing Education and Research) is a nationwide system to indemnify students for the number of days that medical treatment is needed for injury incurred during regular curricular activities and while commuting to or from University (1,000JPY up to 1 year). All students are required to participate in this insurance plan.</li> </ul>
