The framework of role theory has been developed in foreign policy analysis to explain the behavior of states in the international system. However, it has not been applied as a tool for the analysis of bilateral relations. This research analyses Japan–Turkey relations from the framework of national role conceptions by dividing it into six distinct phases in accordance to the different roles assumed by these countries since the beginning of the relations up until today.
